

Hanging Odd Number of Frames in a Row on Mirror Hangers




Mark the center top of where you want the middle frame to sit on the wall.



From the mark you made on the wall measure down the top to center measurement given. Then on either side of that lay out the center to D-ring measurements.




Use the frame you already mapped out as reference for mapping out the frames on either side. Measure out the desired distance between the frames making sure to add the amount of space betweeen the D-rings and the edge of the frame.




Use the Total Distance between the D-rings that's given to measure out where the outer hooks should go.



Repeat steps 3 and 4 using the outer frames as reference until you have any additional frames mapped out.



Make sure all your points are level.



Hammer in all your hooks, making sure that the bottom of the hooks sit at the marks you made.





Slide the D-rings of each frame over the hooks and make sure each frame is secure before letting go.
